

DRESS CODE

The Board of Directors have instructed staff to request members and visitors in breach of this dress code to leave the club premises or course thereafter, your cooperation and understanding would be appreciated to avoid any offence or embarrassment.

THE CLUBHOUSE

Smart casual wear is required at all times.
Wet or soiled clothing is allowed in the locker rooms.
Golf shoes are only allowed in the locker rooms.
Hats, Caps and Visors may only be worn in the locker rooms.

THE COURSE & PRACTICE AREAS

Smart golf wear is required at all times.
Golf shoes must be worn when playing on the course or practice ground.
Shirts must be worn tucked into trousers or shorts.
Trousers must not be tucked into socks except under wet weather wear.
Caps must be worn with the peak at the front.

NOT ALLOWED AT ANY TIME IN CLUBHOUSE OR ON THE COURSE

Trainers*
Collarless or sleeveless shirts.
Football and Rugby shirts or socks.
Sports, Beach, or Tennis shorts; cargo pants or combat trousers.
Track Suits.

*Discretion is allowed for juniors and children under 12 years old.
